<p><b>A.</b></p> <p><b>Categories:</b> Categorize your words into three or more categories. Make sure to label your categories!</p>	<p><b>B.</b></p> <p><b>Complex Sentences:</b> Choose 10 of your words that relate to topics we are learning about in class. Write one complex sentence that includes the word for each of those 10 words.</p>	<p><b>C.</b></p> <p><b>Alphabetical Order:</b> Write each of your spelling words once in alphabetical order.</p>
<p><b>D.</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms and Antonyms:</b> Find one synonym and one antonym for each of your words.</p>	<p><b>E.</b></p> <p><b>Figurative Language:</b> Write each of your words into a metaphor or a simile. (You should have 24 metaphors/similes).</p>	<p><b>F.</b></p> <p><b>Analogies:</b> Choose 12 of your words. Create an analogy for each word. Ex. "A <u>sword</u> is to a warrior as a pen is to a writer". Underline your word</p>
<p><b>G.</b></p> <p><b>Word Ladders:</b> Choose 12 of your words. And create word ladders. Find the root word (this may or may not be your given word) and add prefixes or suffixes to give the word different meanings.</p>	<p><b>H.</b></p> <p><b>Scavenger Hunt:</b> Find your spelling word in any other text and rewrite the sentences in context.</p>	<p><b>I.</b></p> <p><b>Chunking:</b> Write your spelling words and divide them into the appropriate syllables using a / mark.</p>
